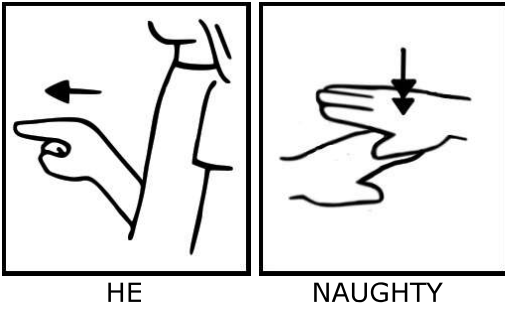


EXPLAINING SITUATIONS

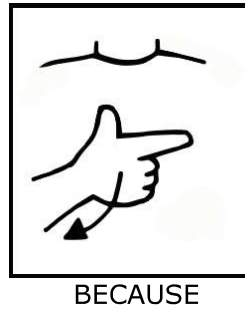
USEFUL TIPS
