If you are Mummy, when with your baby, sign, "MUMMY" each time you see your baby. This way, your baby will recognise the sign as belonging to you. If you are Daddy, sign "DADDY" each time you see your baby.

If you are with your baby, and Daddy comes in the room, point to Daddy and let your child see your Daddy (eye contact is paramount), then get your child's attention and sign, "DADDY" and then turn and look and point at Daddy. When your child looks back at Daddy, have Daddy sign "I'M DADDY" when the child makes eye contact with him. This way, over time, the child will recognise who the sign is referring to.


Please note that for words like "THIS", "THAT", "THERE", "HE", "SHE", "ME", "I", "YOU", and "IT", a simple pointing sign is used.

I'm Mummy. This is Daddy.




Do the same with sisters and brothers (if have any), and relatives. * You can fingerspell initials for their names, and then point to them after you have finished talking:


